ORDINANCE NO 2020-8-3

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH NOISE CONTROL IN THE VILLAGE OF IOLA, CLAY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Whereas, the Village of Iola is a municipality empowered by 65 ILCS 5/11-5-2 to prevent or suppress noises and disturbances in any public or private place; and

Whereas, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Iola have determined that the lack of regulation regarding noise amplification during certain times throughout the Village has caused undesirous conditions for citizens throughout the community; and

Whereas, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Iola desire and have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to establish noise control regulations for the Village of Iola, Illinois, as indicated below.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF IOLA, CLAY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section One: Disturbing the Peace – Amplified Sound

- A. No person shall conduct activities that produce clearly audible sound upon any premises or within any structure which can be heard outside the structure or off the premises from 50 feet or more feet away between the hours of 10:00 pm – 7:00 am during the weeknights and 10pm to 9:00 am during the weekend. Activities include playing of loud music, construction, operation of power tools or power equipment (lawnmowers, tractors, chainsaws etc.) .
- B. Except as provided in Subsection C hereof, no person shall cause or create any electrically amplified sound .
- C. This section shall not apply to the following situations:
 - 1.) Operation of a sound amplification system for announcements and/or music at a carnival, fair, festival or parade with prior approval from the Village President and Board.
 - 2.) Operation of a sound amplification system by police, fire or other emergency personnel or under supervision of a unit of government.
 - 3.) Operation of a sound amplification system as part of a burglar alarm or anti-theft alarm.
